SAFETY NOTICE

CHURCH CAR PARK: It is at this time every year that I need to highlight the difficulties and dangers around drop-off and collection of your child/ren. Already this year we have had two incidents where children have been injured in the church car park. I am asking that all parents exercise extreme caution. To alleviate the difficulty of congestion we are suggesting that all parents make a LEFT TURN when exiting the car park. Please use the designated parking spaces or drop off zone. Children may be left in the playground from 8.45am when supervision commences. No child should be left before this time. Parents who need to drop their child off earlier should register with the Breakfast Club through School Money Online. Teaching will begin at 9am.

<u>WAITING AT THE GATE</u>: Thank you all for your support and cooperation in the mornings whilst leaving your children to school through the main entrance. We would encourage parents not to wait at the gate once they have left their child to school. There are a number of reasons for this. Firstly, by leaving your child off and moving off-site you are freeing up limited parking spaces. Secondly, it can be difficult for children to enter through the gate when parents are gathered there. Finally, as the gate is in close proximity to the entrance of the car park we want to make every effort to ensure that no accidents occur. We would appreciate your cooperation in this matter as the safety of our children is our primary concern. Please pass this information on to anyone who will be responsible for leaving or collecting your child.

<u>ALLERGIES:</u> As we have a growing number of children with nut allergies we ask that foods containing nut products are not included for lunch or break. Please avoid sending in sesame seed products e.g. sesame snaps, seeded breads or crackers. **We** also ask that parents do not send cakes/sweets in for the class on birthdays as some of these will also contain nuts or nut traces.

<u>Curriculum Morning</u>: Many thanks to all the parents who attended the Curriculum Talks. This year the percentage attendance was 55%, a slight increase from 51% attendance the previous year. Following your feedback we intend, certainly for next year, to continue with this practice of holding the meetings at 9am. 
