ALLERGIES: As we have a growing number of children with nut allergies we ask that foods containing nut products are not included for lunch or break. Please avoid sending in sesame seed products e.g. sesame snaps, seeded breads or crackers. Over the course of the year, in St Mary's on the Hill, we have had a very proactive curriculum which helps us to reduce the number of Bullying episodes recorded in the school. Through the pupils' PDMU programme, circle time activities, religion programme and ICT lessons, we limit the amount of relationship issues that can develop into bullying. We also encourage and seek the help of outside agencies such as the NSPCC to deliver assemblies to support the pupils in our school. During Anti-Bullying week, the children will participate in a range of activities on the topic of Anti-Bullying.
