#### **Welcome Back Everyone**

#### **Free School Meals**

"The application process for free school meals/uniform has commenced. Parents who are currently eligible to apply for free meals/uniform should now complete their application. Please note that entitlement to free school meals will attract funding to the school's budget. Whether your child wishes to partake of a meal or not is down to individual choice. We would really encourage parents who fall into this category to please make an application as soon as possible for the incoming academic year. #### **Breakfast Club**

The Breakfast Club is available from 7.45am – 8.45am. The children can have their breakfast - cereal, toast, pancakes, and fruit. There are a variety of games available for them to play and range of movies to watch. As a result of a generous donation by St Vincent de Paul Association the cost of the club will be reduced from £2.50 to £1.50 per child. #### Phone Calls and Messages to the School Office

If parents need to inform teachers of a change in collection, please notify the teacher or office directly in person or by letter that morning. The info email account is not appropriate for urgent messages as the office staff have many other duties to attend to throughout the day. Emails will be checked in the morning and only as time permits throughout the school day. We have recently installed a new telephone system which allows parents to leave voicemails.

Please use the designated parking spaces or drop off zone. Children may be left in the playground from **8.45am** when supervision commences. No child should be left before this time. Parents who need to drop their child off earlier should register with the Breakfast Club. Teaching will begin at 9am.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS: After School Clubs will commence week beginning Monday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2018. You can enrol your child and pay for the after school activity of your choice, through our website, using Paypal. Simply follow the instructions on the screen. This facility will be available on our school website, www.stmarysonthehill.co.uk, from 7.00am on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018 and will close on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> September at 12 noon. #### **Waiting Club**

The Waiting Club operates from 2pm—3pm each day. It costs £2.00 per day per child or £3.00 per family and is available for P1—P3 pupils.

#### **Attendance**

We, in St Mary's on the Hill pride ourselves in the high attendance rate of our pupils, the average attendance last year being 95.5%. It would be great to see this exceeded this year. All absences should be explained by a phone call to the office or note to the teacher. You will find the Holiday List posted on the school website. I would urge you to organise family holidays during these periods only. As far as possible, medical appointments should be made outside school hours. Please inform the school if you wish to withdraw your child from class before the end of the school day. On arrival please call at the school office and Mrs Mason will send for your child.

#### **Administration of Medication**

Please speak to your child's teacher if you require medication administered to your child whilst at school. Parents need to sign and complete an 'Administration of Medication' form (available from the school office) before the school will administer the medicine. All medication needs to be prescribed should have the child's name on it and the dosage clearly labelled. Teachers will not administer medication that is not labelled as such. Please do not send in any medication with your child – it must be handed into the school office by an adult. Thank You.

#### **Healthy Eating/Nut allergies**

Please continue to support our 'Healthy Eating Policy' and provide your child with a piece of fruit and water or milk for break. We have a number of children who suffer from peanut allergies, which can result in potentially serious consequences. I would therefore ask that these children are not exposed to danger and that you do not give your child anything which contains nuts. From time to time parents send buns/cakes/sweets to mark their child's birthday. Please note these food items must be 'NUT FREE'. (Hard sweets or lollipops are not permitted). Parents of children with these diagnosed allergies are asked to provide the school with 2 Epipens (with valid dates) and any other necessary medication as soon as possible.

#### **School Dinners**

Money for dinners should be sent to school on a Monday. The correct amount should be put in an envelope detailing the day/s your child intends to avail of the service. The cost of a school dinner has increased to £2.60.
